You will be sent a list of Future Leaders ‘How To’ suggestions: CV/biography, a corporate headshot and other related and profile support; specific training opportunities; in person and on-line networking and 121 mentoring for career progression.

As a Future Leader you will also automatically be nominated for the Future Leader Award this year and you will be given guidance on how to promote your application.

As part of IRLA’s own succession planning you could also be considered for future board roles and representation*

Enrolling as an IRLA Future Leader does require commitment by the volunteer and support from their employers.

There is no limit as to how many members may join from each member company.
